



NOTIFICATION FOR MOCK TEST AND FINAL PH.D. ENTRANCE TEST (PET -2025) ONLINE EXAMINATION

All the candidates who have applied for Ph.D. Entrance test are hereby requested to take a note of PET - 2025 examination process which is given below.

The list of Eligible Candidates, Conditionally Eligible Candidates and Exempted Candidates will be displayed on the website www.sndt.ac.in. at the earliest and such candidates will be received an email for their application status.

The timetable and the details of PET - Mock Test and the Final PET - 2025 examination are as follows:

**MOCK TEST for an online PET - 2025 examination will be held
on 08.07.2025 between 10:00 a.m. to 06:00 p.m.**

- The University is facilitating a MOCK Test for all Eligible and Conditionally Eligible candidates for practice. Please solve the Mock Test before an attempt of final PET - 2025 online examination. The URL, Login ID and Password will be sent to you on your registered email ID only. You can give your MOCK TEST between 10:00 a.m. to 06:00 p.m.

It should be noted that student will get 1 hour after LOGIN for both the papers separately. There will be no admit card for an online examination.

• Exam Pattern:

- ✓ Questions will be made available only in the medium selected by the candidate for PET while filling application form
- ✓ 50 questions to be attempted from given 55 questions.
- ✓ No Negative Marking for wrong answers.
- ✓ Un-attempted questions will carry zero marks.

**Instructions for candidates who are Eligible or Conditionally
Eligible for PET – 2025 online Examination
(to be held on 10.07.2025)**

- **Conditionally Eligible candidates can appear for the Ph.D. Entrance Test (PET) – 2025 examination which will be held on 10.07.2025. Such candidates are already communicated through email to comply the discrepancy. If discrepancies are not complied then such candidates will not be considered for Interview by the University even though candidate has cleared Ph.D. Entrance Test (PET) – 2025 examination held on 10.07.2025.**
- All the eligible and conditional eligible candidates (List will be updated shortly) are hereby requested to read /check the **"candidate manual"** completely which will be shared with you on your registered email ID. There will be no admit card for the online examination. The URL, Login ID, Password and Time Schedule will be sent to you on your registered email ID only.
- Basic Mandatory requirements for MOCK TEST and PET – 2025 online Examinations are as follows:
 - ✓ Laptop / Desktop/ Android Mobile Phone with an embedded Camera
It is suggested to use Laptop/ Desktop with video camera for the test. One can use mobile phone for the test, but in that case the feature of question panel on the left of the screen and the embedded calculation will not be available. In case you do not have a web camera, you will not be able to take the online examination.
 - ✓ Web Camera Unit
 - ✓ Microphone
 - ✓ Good Quality Internet Connection / WIFI system
 - ✓ Internet Speed should be 1 MBPS
 - ✓ Mobile Phone / Laptop should be fully Charged
Please make sure that your Laptop/mobile phone should be fully charged before appearing for the examination as a measure against unexpected power outages.
 - ✓ Laptop / Desktop with Windows OS – Windows 7 and above are preferred.
 - ✓ Pop-up blocker should be disabled on your browser.
Any notifications related to antivirus, windows update, email notifications, call WhatsApp message, SMS, APP notifications etc. will be counted as navigation. After 05 warnings, your test will be auto submitted.
 - ✓ Make sure you appear for your exam in a noise free and disturbance free environment.

- ✓ Please ensure that you are seated alone in a room for taking the examination. Also ensure that you are seated in a well illuminated area for taking the examination.

• **IMPORTANT STEPS TO FOLLOW:**

- ✓ It is **compulsory** to all the eligible and conditional eligible candidates to log in at **10:30 a.m.** for Paper – I and at **01:30 p.m.** for Paper – II sharp.
- ✓ Login with your login credentials (Login ID , Password, Timings) which will be shared with you on your Registered email ID and Mobile.
- ✓ Click on the "**Start Test**" Button to start the test.
- ✓ Start attempting the questions. Once you have answered all the questions, click on the "**End Test**" button to submit your test.
- ✓ Make sure that you make the final submission only after completing the examination. You will be asked to confirm in case you accidentally try submitting the examination before the completion of the duration. Please note that once you make the final submission, you will not be able to take up the examination again.

• **NOTE :**

- ✓ Mere Qualifying PET or appearance in Ph.D. Interview will not entitle a student for admission.
- ✓ Vacant seats may increase or decrease depending on the availability of resources and or administrative reasons. Reservations as per applicable Maharashtra State Govt. Rules.
- ✓ All correspondence shall be made on the email id given by the candidate in the application form.
- ✓ University shall not be responsible for any lapse of intimation on account of wrong Email – Id.
- ✓ Candidates must remain in touch with the latest directions/ updates on the University website.
