

Shrimati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey (SNDT) Women's University is one of the pioneers in the Home Science education in the country. The university that marked its inception in 1916, shifted its headquarters to Bombay in 1936 and received statutory recognition in 1951. Being first women's university in South-East Asia, SNDTWU completed 101 glorious years in 2017.

It was founded by Bharat Ratna Maharshi Dr. Dhondo Keshav Karve in 1916, in Pune, to support the cause of women's empowerment through higher education. The university operates from 3 campuses; Churchgate (headquarters), Juhu and Pune. The university offers 250 programmes ranging from Undergraduate to Ph.D. as well as Diploma and Postgraduate Diploma programmes through 15 Faculties.

About Home Science

Home Science education equip students with broad range of skills and careers in contrast to common perception that it is confined to cooking, stitching and child rearing etc. There is need to change this perception of Home Science among common people.
