I) Board of Studies in Master of Social Work

•The revision of M.S.W. syllabus as per the new structure of PG programme:

Information/Discussion:

BOS in Master of Social Work has prepared the syllabus for M.S.W. Semester I, II, III and IV as per the guidelines of P.G. Programme structure approved by the Academic Council. The revised syllabus will be implemented from the academic year 2020-21. The discussion was held and members felt that the revised syllabus for M.S.W. be accepted.

Resolution of faculty :

It is resolved that the revised syllabus for M.S.W. - Sem. I, II, III and IV be placed before the Academic Council to approve the same.

Resolution passed at Academic Council dated 18.06.2020:

III) Board of Studies in Psychology

• The revision of MA syllabus for Psychology as per the new structure of PG programme:

Information/Discussion:

The syllabus prepared by BOS in Psychology by circulation was presented before the Faculty by Dr. Anuradha Sovani, the Chairperson of the BOS. The members of the Faculty accepted the syllabus of M.A Psychology for Semester I, II, III and IV which will be commencing from the academic year 2020-21.

Resolution of faculty:

It was resolved that the revised syllabus accepted by the Faculty be placed before the Academic Council for its approval.

• Lateral entry from other Universities to SNDT WU UG programme:

Information/Discussion:

The Chairperson of BOS in Psychology inform the members that the students from other Universities who do not get admission in TYBA of their own University due to limited seats, our colleges/university can take the advantage of it through the lateral entry.

A committee had been constituted in 2017 with permission of Honorable Madam Vice Chancellor, and they have worked out the content of the undertaking for making up a shortfall of 10 credits, to be taken from students of University of Mumbai seeking admission to SNDT WU.

She also informed that the matter which was presented and discussed earlier in Psychology BOS and was also approved in the Academic Council meeting be accepted along with minutes of the meeting where the decision was taken and with letter of OSD approval. The document minuting this committee decision is attached and the same was duly passed in the Academic Council meeting of June 2020. The members of the Faculty considered and approved the same.

Resolution passed at Academic Council dated 18.06.2020: Resolved that, syllabus of M.A Psychology for Semester I, II, III and IV be

accepted and approved.

Resolved that, permission be granted for lateral entry for Psychology students into UG program of SNDT WU from University of Mumbai on following conditions:

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"Lateral entry can be permitted in SYBA at SNDT WU if they give an undertaking of completing 8 credits of Developmental Psychology in the course of Semesters III and IV, appearing for those papers with college students of Semester I and II respectively, as well as an assignment of one credit each on General Psychology during Semester III and IV respectively.

They can be granted lateral entry into TYBA at SNDT WU, if they comply with the above requirement, as well as appear for papers in Personality Theories and Psychological Testing and assessment in the course of their Semesters V and VI, appearing for the same with students of Semesters III and IV."

IV) Board of Studies in Sociology

The revision of MA syllabus for Sociology as per the new structure of PG programme:

Information/Discussion:

The Chairperson of the Board of Studies in Sociology Dr. Smriti Bhosle presented the revised syllabus of M.A. in Sociology. The syllabus has been prepared for semester I & II as per the new P. G. Programme Structure approved by the Academic Council. All the members of the Faculty accepted it.

Resolution of faculty :

Resolved that the revised syllabus of M.A. in Sociology be accepted and it is to be placed before the Academic Council for its approval.

a. The revision of MA syllabus for Geography as per the new structure of PG programme:

Information/Discussion:

The minutes of the meeting of Board of Studies in Geography have been presented by Dr. Sachin Deore, the Chairperson of BOS. The sub-committees formed by the Board and revised the syllabus of M.A. Geography and then it has circulated among the members of the BOS in Geography. Members of the Faculty discussed on the same and accepted it. Resolution of faculty :

It is resolved that the revised Syllabus of M.A. Geography be accepted and be recommended to the Academic Council to approve the same.

Resolution passed at Academic Council dated 18.06.2020:

Resolved that, the revised Syllabus of M.A. Geography be accepted and approved.

b. Change in the evaluation pattern:

Information/Discussion:

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The Chairperson of the BOS in Geography placed before the committee the matter of evaluation pattern. The members of the BOS in Geography suggested that the existing pattern of 50 percent internal and 50 percent external evaluation be changed to 25% internal evaluation and 75% external evaluation for M.A. Geography. The members of the Faculty approved it.

Resolution of faculty :

It is resolved that, the evaluation pattern with 25% Internal Evaluation and 75% External Evaluation for M.A. Geography be recommended to the Academic Council for its approval.

Resolution passed at Academic Council dated 18.06.2020:

Resolved that, the evaluation pattern with 25% Internal Evaluation and 75% External Evaluation for M.A. Geography be accepted and approved.

c. To approve Certificate courses as follows:

- (i) Certificate course in Geoinformatics
- (ii) Certificate course in Surveying
- (iii) Certificate course in Travel and Tourism.

Information/Discussion:

The BOS in Geography has prepared the certificate courses as follows:

- 1) Certificate course in Geoinformatics
- 2) Certificate course in Surveying
- 3) Certificate course in Travel and Tourism.

The Chairperson of BOS in Geography gave details of each course. All the members of the Faculty accepted and approved the proposal of certificate courses.

Resolution of faculty :

It was resolved that the proposals of Certificate courses be recommended to the Academic Council for its approval.

Resolution passed at Academic Council dated 18.06.2020:

Resolved that, the following certificate courses be accepted and approved in the subject of Geography

- 1) Certificate course in Geoinformatics
- 2) Certificate course in Surveying
- 3) Certificate course in Travel and Tourism.

Resolved further that, a small committee of academic council be constituted to standardize the certificate, diploma and P. G Diploma in terms of credits and duration and the Vice- Chancellor be authorized to constitute the same wherein members from all faculties can be taken.

Resolved further that, the fee structures of the certificate courses be forwarded to the Fee fixation committee.

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d. Eligibility criteria for admission to MA Geography:

Information/Discussion:

At present the eligibility criteria for admission in M.A. Geography is as follows:

- Graduate in Geography from this university or any other recognized University.
- Students from other subjects should have completed 8 courses of 4 credits each with at least one course of practical of 4 credits at graduation.

The members of the BOS in Geography felt that it restricts the admissions in the discipline. Therefore, the eligibility criteria be changed as follows:

- Any Graduate from this university or any other recognized University who has completed graduation with at least 4 credits course of practical in Geography should be given admission to MA Geography.

Members of the Faculty accepted and approved the recommendations of the B.O.S in Geography.

Resolution of faculty :

Resolved that the recommendations of the B.O.S. in Geography be placed before the Academic Council to approve the same.

Resolution passed at Academic Council dated 18.06.2020:

Resolved that, the eligibility criteria for admission in M.A. Geography be accepted and approved as follows:

"Any Graduate from this university or any other recognized University who has completed graduation with at least 4 credits course of practical in Geography should be given admission to MA Geography."

e. To discuss the matter of consideration of Geography subject under the Faculty of Science and Technology:

Information/Discussion:

The mater of inclusion of the Geography in the Faculty of Science and Technology was discussed. As per 'Maharashtra Public University Act-2016', there are only four Faculties which do not include the Faculty of Social Sciences. Thus, many Universities in the Maharashtra included Geography subject in the Faculty of Science and Technology. Some of the Universities are as follows: 'Savitribai Phule Pune University', Pune, 'Shivaji University', Kolhapur, and 'Kavyitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University', Jalgaon.

The Chairperson of BOS in Geography emphasizes the advantages of this inclusion are: the Department of Geography can apply for various schemes of the Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India to obtain various awards and grants. Also the degree offered at present is M.A. in Geography; the Department may offer M.Sc. degree too, which may help to allow graduate students from Science Faculty to enroll for the course, which will help in increasing the enrolment of students. Also, Geography now a day's gaining importance in the field of GIS and Remote Sensing or Geo-informatics or Geo-technologies. This widens the scope of the subject to introduce such programs.

Resolution of faculty :

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It is resolved that the inclusion of Geography under the Faculty of Science and Technology be forwarded to the Board of Deans for its consideration and BOD will placed it before the Academic Council to approve the same. Discussion:

The said matter be first discussed with the joint director of the concerned region stating that if the University changes the faculty will the same affect the salary grant of the teachers. Then we can prepare the proposal to bring out the change.

Resolution passed at Academic Council dated 18.06.2020: Resolved that, the said matter be referred back.
