1. Shanta Gambhir Memorial lecture delivered by Heather Goodall on “A Feminist in practice: Kapila Khandavala in Bombay (1930-1940)”

Smt. Shanta Gambhir Memorial Lecture

The Lecture was instituted in the Department of History from the bank interest over grant of Rs. 1, 00, 000/- donated by Mr. Gambhir in 2001 in memory of his late wife Smt. Shanta Gambhir who completed collegiate and post-graduate education while handling the house-hold. She was a student of Department of History, S.N.D.T. Women's University for her post-graduate education. She was extremely hard-working and honest. As per the wish of the donor, the lecture in her memory, every alternate year, is conducted on a theme related to the area of women's history/women's question/social reform pertaining to women.

For the year 2021, Prof. Emerita Dr. Heather Goodall was invited to deliver the Smt. Shanta Gambhir Memorial Lecture. She Prof. Goodall is a historian who has researched and published on Indigenous histories, environmental history and decolonisation histories in India, Australia and the eastern Indian Ocean. As chair person, Dr. Nafini Manjrekar was invited who is Professor and former Dean, School of Education, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai.

Dr. Goodall took a sketch of the life story of Kapila Khandvala. She gave a brief sketch in the beginning of her educational career. After her first degree, Kapila won a Barbour Women's scholarship in 1930 to study for her master's in Education at the University of Michigan, United States of America. Kapila returned via Europe, where she visited schools across Western Europe and the Soviet Union. After a period of teaching in Bombay, she represented India at the International Students Federation conference in Prague. In 1937, Kapila delivered the article 'Primary and Secondary Education in India' to the World Federation of Education Associations conference in Tokyo, then lectured at a number of Chinese universities on 'Indian problems'. She returned to work at a social work centre in Bombay, undertaking outreach literacy work in rural villages, until appointed principal of a training college for women in mid-1938. In August 1941, she was appointed secretary of the Bombay Municipal Schools Committee, making her the first woman in India to be appointed as the head of an education department.

Dr. Goodall further analysed the role of Kapila Khandvala in the feminist politics in India in the 1930s. Kapila had been active in the AIWC before the National Federation was formed and she came to Australia in 1946 as a representative of the AIWC. She strongly supported the formation of

the NFIW, with its attention to economic and caste issues, and she was elected as its president in the 1960s. Nevertheless, she retained close links with many women in the AIWC and did not join the CPI, although she worked closely with many National Federation women who were members of the CPI.

Dr. Manjrekar analysed the contribution of the feminist politics in India in Pre-independence times.

Nearly 80 participants attended the talk. Dr. Sangle at the end, delivered the vote of thanks.

Ms. Supriya Sule, politician and member of Indian Parliament launched the series of public lectures to introduce the contribution made by various social reformers such as Mahatma Phule, Shahu Maharaj and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar for women for the masses. As a part of this series, Dr. Jaswandi Wamburkar was invited to deliver a talk on the contribution of Mahatma Phule and Savitribai Phule for the women's emancipation.

Dr. Jaswanti Wamburkar analysed how the contribution of Mahatma Phule and Savitribai Phule proved seminal to the feminist movement in India. She pointed out that the feminist thought developed by Mahatma Phule is still influential and relevant in today's world. She opined that the Bahujan / lowercaste / lower-class woman was always at the centre of his thought as well as action. He showed the consciousness that the issue of caste and gender was interrelated and that Indian women was not a monolithic category. It is noteworthy that his writings showed both the sensitivity and understanding of the fact that there existed diversity of patriarchies in terms of castes in India with varying degree of exploitation of women therein.

Dr. Wamburkar took a review of his work as the pioneer in the education of the Shudra-girls in India. Mahatma Phule's three disciples Savitribai, Mukta and Tarabai are the testimony of his radical movement. Mukta's essay is a clear indication of Phule's subversive message. No other women's writings of nineteenth century could show the radical spirit of Tarabai Shinde's 'Stree-Purush Tulana.' She illustrated how Mahatma Phule and Savitribai Phule showed the rare courage of starting an orphanage for the fallen women and their children. Savitribai used to look after the pregnant women as well as the children. By this act they clearly demonstrated and propagated women's sexual freedom.

Dr. Wamburkar also brought out the contribution of Savitribai who was not a typical docile Indian woman; rather she was a very courageous woman who stood by the side of her husband and supported all his radical activities when other family-members of Jotirao resisted and finally deserted him. She also analysed the poetry of Savitribai as collection of poetry 'Kavyaphule' published in 1854. She summed up that Savitribai's literature echoed the agony, aspirations, and feelings of the modern liberated Indian woman. Dr. Wamburkar rightly regarded Savitribai as the 'first modern Indian radical (Vidrohi) poet'.

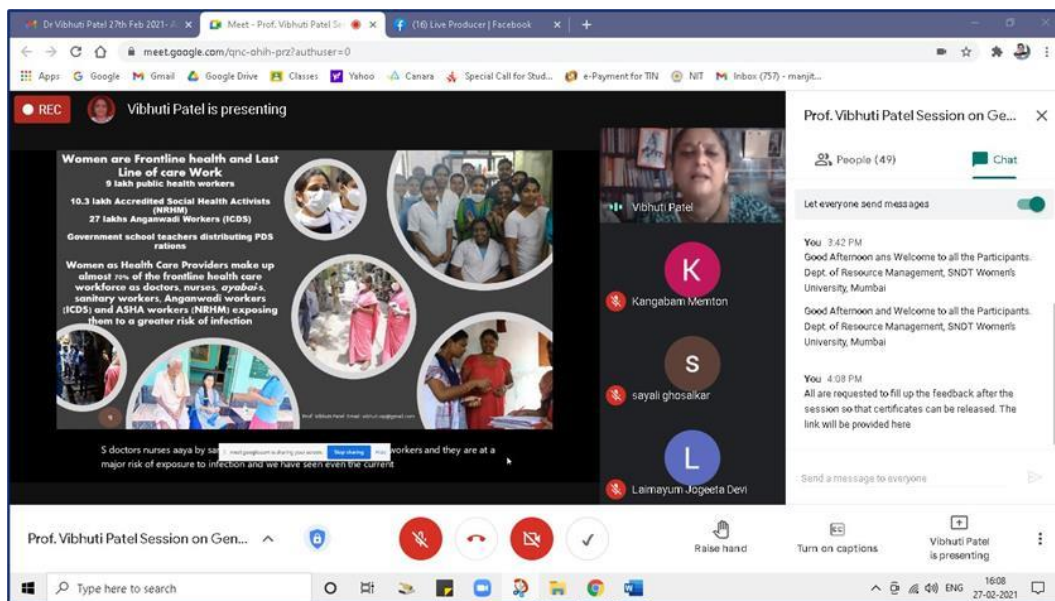
Prof. Vibhuti Patel in her presentation highlighted on 5 major issues:

AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into at Mumbai on this 4th day of November 2019 between SNTD Women's University, Churchgate, Mumbai 400020 (hereinafter referred to as SNTD Women's University) and M/s. Balaji Security Force (India), (hereinafter referred to as "Agency") of the Other Part, stating the terms and conditions of Security Services to be provided at SNTD Women's University, Churchgate Campus, JuhuKanyashala Campus in Mumbai 400020 on Contractual basis.



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A. SCOPE OF SECURITY SERVICES :

1. The Security Services are to cover entire area which signed to them of Juhu Campus, Churchgate Campus (including Kanyashala Campus), Pune campus and Ahmadabad site of the SNDT Univeristy and its specifically covering all building and open area within the campus.
2. The Agency will provide security for external as well as internal area of the building situated within the area mentioned above.

B. GENERAL CONDITIONS :

1. It will be the responsibility of the Agency to make suitable arrangement for proper and efficient Security Services to guard the movable and immovable property of the University all buildings and premises of SNDT, Juhu and Churchgate (including Kanhashala, Girgaon), Pune campus and Ahmadabad site
2. The Security Services will be required to extend 24 hours all days including National Holidays, Security should be provided for 24 hours round the clock.
3. No residential facilities will be made available to Security Guards, Supervisor or any other representatives of the Agency within the Campus of SNDT Women's University, Pune campus and Ahmadabad site.
4. The Agency shall not transfer or assign or share benefit of this Agreement with anyone else representatives of the Agency within the Campus of SNDT Women's University, Pune campus and Ahmadabad site.
5. The Agency shall at all times indemnify the SNDT Women's University, Pune campus and Ahmadabad site against all claims for compensation under the provisions of any law the time being in force/brought into force, by or in respect of any workman employed by the Agency in carrying out the contract and against all costs and expenditure incurred by the SNDT Women's University shall be entitled to deduct any amount due from all the money paid or payable by way of compensation as aforesaid and costs or expenses in connection with any claim thereto. For this purpose, an Indemnity Bond will have to be executed.
6. The Agency will co-operate with other agencies if any on SNDT Women's University Juhu and Churchgate Campus(including Kanhashala, Girgaon), Pune campus and Ahmadabad site while performing their duties.
7. It will be the responsibility of the agency to carry out investigation in the case of theft and any other Security problems arising at SNDT Women's University Juhu and Churchgate Campus (including Kanhashala, Girgaon), Pune campus and Ahmadabad site. Agency will take up the matter with Police authorities and follow it up on behalf of the SNDT Women's University.
8. Security Guards duty should be changed after every month.
9. All the legal formalities required in engaging security personal will be the responsibility of the Agency.
10. The agency will have to follow the norms/guidelines of the discipline as directed by the SNDT Women's University.
11. Any dispute arising out of terms of this contract or interpretations of any clause herein shall be mutual discussion between the nominated authorities of the SNDT Women's University and the agency or its authorized



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representatives. the SNTD Women's University will be the final authority in resolving such disputes.

12. If in the course of execution of this contract by the agency, any minor or major damage is caused by the agency or his workmen to the person or property of the gratuity or any other allowance, leave salary, wages for holidays or any compensation notice pay etc.
13. The agency shall regularly make payment of the Provident Fund, Family Pension Employees State Insurance Contribution, Deposit Linked Insurance Scheme and all other statutory dues that may become due or payable by the agency for the labor employed by them and maintain all such records as may be statutory required and produce the same to the office along with the bills in respect of dues paid in previous month (name wise). If agency fails to submit all documents along with bill payment will not be made.
14. A complete list of security guards/supervisor along with their bio-data photographs, including their local as well as permanent address, etc. should be submitted to the Registrar, the SNTD Women's University at sub campus before they are employed. Changes should be informed to the Security Officer SNTD Women's University when they take place. The short bio-data along with photograph of all guards should be available with office of Registrar, the SNTD Women's University.
15. In case the workers engaged by the agency have any grievance, they will take it up with the agency without any distains on the Juhu and Churchgate Campus(including Kanhashala, Girgaon), Pune campus and Ahmadabad site were to agitation resulting in damage to the SNTD Women's University.
16. In case of lapses on the part of guards as explained in duties and responsibilities of Security Guard Contract, a fine of Rs.500/- per occasion of lapses will be charged to Agency. Any loss caused to the SNTD Women's University due to such lapses will have to be made good by Agency.
17. Agency will also keep watch on unauthorized encroachments in the areas and will take suitable actions immediately.
18. Leave should be pre-sanctioned by the guard and it should be managed by supervisor.

C.STYLE OF FUNCTIONING :

1. A Guard and supervisor will be stationed at main entrance who will control the handle by the guard/supervisor. Entries of all vehicles etc. should be made by this staff in the registrar properly and timely.
2. The Security supervisor of the agency should give surprise visits on regular basis to ensure smooth functioning. He shall report to the security office,



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SNDT women's university at Churchgate Campus, Pune camp Ahmadabad site each day in the morning at 10.00 am.

3. The Fire protection equipment shall be provided by the SNDT V University within the campus and it will be the responsibility of the a ensure that they are in order. The Security personnel should be well trained to handled such firefighting equipment. Security personnel will also have to handle fire protection equipment outside the buildings but within the campus.
4. The Security personnel placed at the main gate should inspect the identity card of person employed by the other contract agencies, casual workers, domestic help, the SNDT Women's University after joint investigation by the SNDT Women's University and the "Agency" any claims arising thereof shall be recovered, settled and dealt with directly by the agency and the agency shall render all assistance and co-operation to the SNDT Women's University if any enquiry is held thereon.
5. The SNDT Women's University will pay Rs.24478/- Per month (Rupees Twenty Four Thousand Four Hundred Seventy Eight only) per security guard at all campuses, and Rs.26603/- per month (Rupees Twenty Six Thousand Six Hundred Three only) for Security supervisor at all campuses of SNDT Women's University (inclusive of taxes).

D. AGENCY'S RESPONSIBILITY:

1. The quality of work should be as per standards laid down and explained to the agency.
2. The Security Guards shall be of the age below 45 years and shall be medically fit, healthy, strong built, with no color blindness or night blindness. The Security should not sit at a place but shall take care that entry inside the SNDT Women's University, all the campuses are restricted and outsiders or intruder not admitted without sufficient enquiry through investigation. The guard shall be very alert and vigilant in his duties. The guards shall be provided thick wooden lathi by the agency, which will be carried at the time by them. Security Guards shall all the times be inform provided by the agency. Agency with its own cost mist provided security personnel necessary winter clothing, raincoats, torch and stationery such as registers, files etc. The uniform of supervisor shall be distinct form that of Security Guards. The Security personnel employed by the agency should be provided with identity cards. The identity cards should be promptly displayed by each guard on their left hand shirt pocket.
3. The Agency shall ensure that it fully complies with and observe all the provisions of the Labor Contract Act (Regulation and Abolition Act) 1970, the Minimum Wages Act 1949, payment of wages Act, Employees Provident Fund and Miscellaneous provision Act, the ESI Act and such other.
20. The location of security should be changed on monthly basis as for as possible.
21. The register for visitors and vehicles should be maintained.



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22. The complaint register should be maintained and should be signed by complained and guard.
23. The duties of the guard should be displayed on the gate by the agency.
24. Unknown vehicles should not be allowed to enter and parked in University Campus.
25. Round should be taken at night every one hours and the supervisor should sign that register.

DUTIES OF SECURITY GUARD:

1. On public holidays and Sundays, hall gate should be shut down all the time. The hall gate should be open during 8.00 am to 11.00 am and procedure as mentioned above should be followed strictly. Double duty should not be given to any guard i.e. Maximum 31-35 days of each guard can be tolerated.
2. On the holidays, if any member demand of request to open any office, written permission should be collected from the concerned staff member, duly signed by the Competent Authority or other Officers, entries should made in respective register.
3. On the holidays and after office hours, Post/Tapal/Parcel etc. should be collected at the date itself and entries should be made in respective register and delivery may be given to the concerned officer and obtain acknowledgement.
4. Theft incidences should be reported by agency to Police Station and copy of the same may be handed over to the Juhu and Churchgate Campus (including Kanyashala), Pune campus and Ahmadabad site Deputy Registrar/ Security Officer of SNTD women's university.
5. All staff members of Agency should be checked at the gate and should not be allowed to enter from other wicket gate. Agency's ex-staff should not be allowed inside the gate.
6. It will be the responsibility of the Agency to ensure that the lights within buildings/rooms are put off after office hours. Also street lights, corridor lights to be put on and off as per sunset and sunrise and all rooms are locked properly.
7. SNTD Women's University reserves right to accept or reject any particular security guards/supervisor placed on duty to SNTD Women's University at all the campuses.
8. The SNTD Women's University shall accept no claim in the event of any of the agency's security personnel sustaining any injury, damage or loss to either person or property either inside or outside the SNTD Women's University Juhu and Churchgate Campus (including Kanyashala).
9. The Security Guards employees employed by the agency will be employees and SNTD Women's University in no way be responsible or liable for their wages, salaries, bonus employed by campus residents, no person shall enter the premises of the SNTD Women's University without identity card/ temporary passes.



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10. All visitors visiting the SNTD Women's University, except programs participants/guest speakers/VVIP's should be issued visitors/ pass, in prescribed format and ensured that these are returned back duly signed by the person visited at the gate, unless the visitor's slip is returned no person shall be permitted to leave the campus.
11. Security Personnel of the agency should see, that no stray animals such as cows, buffaloes, goats, dogs etc. enter the premises of the SNTD Women's University campus or no person shall enter the premises through the fence. If such animals do enter, it will be responsibility of the agency to remove them from the premises.
12. The Security personnel at the date should see that vehicles of private parties, contract agencies etc. are checked properly and maintain a register for inward-outward movement of all the vehicles.
13. In case of any lapses in security services found repeatedly within a month, the SNTD Women's University has full right to deduct 25% of the services charges to be paid by the SNTD Women's University.
14. Agency will have to do any other duties as assigned by the SNTD Women's University though Dy.Registrar / Security Officer.

E. PAYMENT:

1. The agency shall enter into contract with SNTD Women's University as soon as decision in this regard is taken on stamp paper worth Rs.100/- (Rupees One Hundred only).
2. SNTD Women's University make efforts to process monthly payment before within 15 working days on receipt of bills from the agency.
3. The contract will be for the period of Six months i.e. 01.11.2019 to 30.04.2020, which is renewable by further two years only at the sole discretion of SNTD Women's University.

F. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT:

During the currency of this Agreement the SNTD Women's University will have the right to terminate this Agreement if they are not satisfied with the performance of the agency by giving them 10 days' notice in writing. For this purpose the SNTD Women's University will be sole judge to decide SNTD Women's University whether the performance of the agency is satisfactory or not and the decision of the SNTD Women's University will be final, conclusive and binding on the agency and the agency shall not be entitled to any compensation in that regard. Furthermore, if no account of non-renewal if the contract and/or termination of this contract, the agency has to terminate its employees then it shall be the responsibility of the agency to pay the legal




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

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dues to its employees. In the event of non-compliance of legal provisions or non-payment or dues, the agency itself shall be liable for all costs and consequences and the SNDT Women's University in any case will not be responsible for the same.


