Date of Arrival : 3rd October – 9.00 pm
All colleges and institutes are required to bring the flag of their respective institution for the march past.

2. Eligibility:

- i. Participants must be actively enrolled students at their respective institutions.
- ii. Only students who are under 25 years of age as of July 1, 2024, are eligible to participate

3. Registration:

- i. Please register all individuals and teams participating in the tournament by filling out the Google form link provided in the email. The registration deadline is **28 September, 2024.**

4. Documentation:

- i. Upon arrival, each College/Institute must present the following documents at the registration desk for verification:
 - a. *Covering Letter*
 - b. *Entry Form*
 - c. *Eligibility Form – "C"*
 - d. *Copy of Identity Card*
 - e. *Fee Receipt of Participant*
 - f. *12th Grade Mark - sheet*
 - g. *Fitness Certificate*
 - h. *Copy of previous academic year's College Annual Sports Fee & Krida Mahotsav (Ashwamedh) Fee receipt submitted to the University.*

5. Code of Conduct:

- i. All participants are required to demonstrate sportsmanship, respect, and fairness at all times.
- ii. Discrimination, harassment, or any form of disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- iii. Any rule violations or misconduct will be addressed by the disciplinary committee.
- iv. Penalties or disqualification may be imposed based on the disciplinary committee's decisions for any violations.
- v. All teams must report to the officiating desk at least 30 minutes before their scheduled match.

6. Tournament structure:

- i. All disciplines must adhere to the rules and regulations set forth by the AIU (Association of Indian Universities).
- ii. A meeting to determine the fixtures will be held. The format of play will be announced during this meeting.
- iii. All games and matches will follow the standard rules of each sport as prescribed by the AIU, with any necessary modifications for the tournament.

7. Team Composition:

2.	Wrestling	As per Weight Category (One in each)

8. Kit:

- All the participants must be dressed in appropriate uniform – T-shirt, Shorts/ Skirt/ Track – pant, socks and shoes during all matches and March past.

9. Referees & Officials:

- Matches will be officiated by certified referees or officials.
- The decisions of referees/officials are final and binding.

10. Travel Allowance:

- Travel allowance for 2nd class train or bus journeys will be provided upon submission of tickets, T.A./D.A. forms, and a list of students with their signatures. These documents must be sent to the department via courier within 15 days of the tournament.
- Internal travel expenses incurred within Mumbai will not be reimbursed.

11. Accommodation:

- Accommodation will be provided for participants, coaches, and team managers who reside outside Mumbai for the duration of the tournament.
- An accommodation fee of Rs. 100 per person for the entire tournament must be submitted to the host college at the time of arrival at the registration desk.
- Participants, coaches, and team managers are requested to bring their own bedsheets and blankets.
- Accommodation will only be provided for individuals listed on the eligibility proforma. Any additional persons accompanying the team will be responsible for their own accommodation and food expenses.

12. Food:

- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be provided to all participants, coaches, and team managers.
- Mess charges of Rs. 250 per day per person for two days must be submitted to the host college at the time of arrival at the registration desk.
- Mess charges for Mumbai Colleges will be Rs. 150 per day per person for two days must be submitted to the host college at the time of arrival at the registration desk.

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13. Awards & Recognition:

- Merit certificates will be awarded to teams and individual players as per winning criteria viz. I, II, III places respectively.
- Certificate of participation will be provided to all participating athletes.

14. Annual Sports & Krida Mahotsav Fee:

- All colleges/ Institutes are requested to submit previous academic year's receipt of their Annual Sports Fee and Krida Mahotsav (Ashwamedh) fee at the time of arrival at the registration desk.
